REBATE REQUIREMENTS

- Clothes washer must be ENERGY STAR certified
- The ENERGY STAR certified clothes washer must be installed in a participating utility's service area
- Must be a residential electric customer of a participating New Hampshire utility
- Limit of 2 clothes washer rebates per year
- Cannot be combined with any other utility offering
- Purchase must be made between January 1, 2017 and December 31, 2017. *Rebate is a limited time offer while funds are available and may be subject to change at any time*
- Rebate must be postmarked or submitted online no later than **January 31, 2018**

CLOTHES WASHER BEST PRACTICES

Always use high-efficiency (HE) detergent

Using regular detergent creates too many suds, which will affect the machine's washing and rinsing performance.

Fill it up

Clothes washers use about the same amount of energy regardless of the size of the load, so run full loads whenever possible.

Wash in cold water

Water heating consumes about 90 percent of the energy it takes to operate a clothes washer. Switching your temperature setting from hot to warm can cut energy use in half. Using the cold cycle reduces energy use even more.

Activate the high spin speed option

If your clothes washer has spin options, choose a high spin speed or the extended spin option to reduce the amount of remaining moisture in your clothes after washing. This decreases the amount of time and energy it takes to dry your clothes.
