LOW INCOME DISCOUNT PROGRAM

Effective December 1, 2008, customers taking service under the Residential Non-Heating rate may be eligible to receive a 30% discount on delivery and gas supply rates. This discount will apply to all customers identified by the Maine State Housing Authority as eligible for LIHEAP. Once enrolled, customers will receive the discount for 12 consecutive months.

MINIMUM BILL

The Minimum Bill shall be the applicable Monthly Customer Charge.

TERMS OF CONTRACT

Contract for service shall be for a period of one year.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Bills are payable by the due date. A late charge equal to that allowed by the Commission pursuant to Chapter 870 of the Commission's rules will be assessed on all balances that remain unpaid at the end of each billing period, said period to be no less than 25 days from date of postmark.

TURN-ON CHARGE
