ELECTRIC DEFINITIONS

Customer Charge: A monthly fixed charge that recovers the cost of meter reading, equipment, maintenance, and customer services. The Customer Charge does not change when your electric use increases or decreases.

Distribution Charge: This charge recovers the cost of delivering electricity through Unitil's distribution system to your premises. These charges are the operating and maintenance costs and the investment made to the distribution system. Also included in this charge are costs to provide low income programs.

Transmission Charge: This charge recovers the cost of transmitting bulk power over high voltage power lines from the generation source to Unitil's distribution system.

Net Metering Recovery Surcharge: This charge recovers net metering credits applied to customers with excess generation from on-site generation facilities (i.e. agricultural, gas, solar, or wind facilities).

Distributed Solar Charge: A charge that recovers the costs associated with the Solar Massachusetts Renewable Target Program. The goal of this state-wide program is to create a long-term sustainable solar incentive program that promotes cost-effective solar development in the Commonwealth.

Energy Efficiency Charge: Includes a state-mandated system benefits charge that provides funds to Untill to provide energy efficiency programs for all customers and the energy efficiency reconciliation factor (which recovers additional funds to support expanded energy efficiency initiatives.

Renewable Resource Charge: A state-mandated charge that provides funds to the State for research and development of environmentally-clean power sources such as solar, wind, biomass and hydro.

Rate SD and SDC Supplier Charges, as shown on the other side,

also apply to this service.

Basic Service Charge: This charge recovers the costs of electricity purchased for your use. All Unitil customers have the option to purchase electricity supply from competitive suppliers. If you do not choose another supplier, you will continue to receive your electricity supply from Unitil's Basic Service. Basic Service has two price options: a fixed price option and a monthly variable price.

GAS DEFINITIONS:

Customer Charge: The fixed monthly charge that recovers the cost of meter reading, equipment, maintenance, and customer services. The Customer Charge does not change when your usage of natural gas increases or decreases.

Distribution Charge: The cost of delivering natural gas through Unitil's pipes to your home or business. It includes our operating and maintenance costs, investment in the pipe and other equipment to meet your needs.

Distribution Adjustment Charge: This charge recovers other operating and maintenance costs not reflected in the distribution charge including certain environmental costs, costs of low-income programs, energy efficiency programs, and other costs or credits.

Supplier Service / Default Service Charge: This charge recovers the cost of acquiring gas for your use and having that gas shipped to Unitil's gas distribution system. All Unitil customers have the option to purchase natural gas from a competitive supplier. If you do not choose another supplier, you will continue to receive your natural gas from Unitil's Default Service.
